



Art and Design Department

The Art and Design Department is a team of two full-time teachers, one part-time teacher and one part-time technician. The subject is taught from Key Stage 3 through to Key Stage 4 and 5. The demand for Art & Design is always high at GCSE and A-level, with results from CCEA examinations proving excellent year-on-year. This year, the Department produced four of the highest scoring (100%) candidates for Art & Design in Northern Ireland at AS Level.

Our programme of study covers drawing, painting, print-making, fashion and textiles, ceramics, sculpture, digital art and art history and appreciation. Pupils are assessed regularly through assigned homework, internal controlled assessments and annual assessment / drawing examinations.

The Department is well resourced with three large teaching rooms, each with a shared resource room, a cluster of laptops and a ceramics room with a kiln.

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
